With great pleasure I present before you the annual report of academic year 2019-2020, Majlis Arts And Science College, Puramannur:-

The academic year started on 3rd June – 2019. There were 16 UG programmes and 7 PG programmes out of which BA Visual communication started during the year 2019 – 2020. There were 1906 UG students and 170 PG students, which includes 1116 Male Students and 960 female students repectively in the total student strength 2076. The total number of teaching staff were 103 and Non teaching staff were 27.

On 30-07-2019 an international seminar on "Marine Chemistry an overview" was conducted by the PG Department of Chemistry.Dr. Muhammed Najeem from the Qatar University was the resource person.
